Subject	Start Date	End Date	Description
Music	01/03/2021	19/03/2021	Three week class based presentation / performance of two pieces from their composition portfolio
Home Economics	02/11/2020	22/12/2020	Decorative textile item for the home e.g. cushion, using embroidery and applique. Support folder written, giving details of processes involved in the project. All sewing done during class time.
Art	06/01/2021	14/05/2021	6-8 week development of art design craft project. Based on given title to be issued in early January 'From Process to Realisation' gives students an opportunity to experience an approach that reflects that of a practising artist.
Business Studies	18/01/2021	12/02/2021	Finance in Action: Conduct research, evaluate information, develop action plan, report findings.
Science	12/04/2021***	04/05/2021***	3 week lab based project. Week 1: Preparation. Week 2: Write up hypothesis testing. Week 3: Experimentation, conclusion, application.
English	02/11/2020	27/11/2020	Students prepare an oral presentation of three minutes on a topic of interest to them. This will be completed over a three week period and then presented to their year group.
French	08/03/2021	26/03/2021	Students must speak for three minutes in French on a topic they have prepared over three weeks in class. This can be a presentation, an interview or a dialogue. This is followed by oral questions by the teacher.
German	08/03/2021	26/03/2021	Students must speak for three minutes in German on a topic they have prepared over three weeks in class. This can be a presentation, interview or dialogue. This is followed by oral questions by teacher.
Maths	08/03/2021***	26/03/2021***	Mathematical Investigation - Any format of student's choice, a report, presentation etc.
Geography	06/01/2021	27/01/2021	Geography in the News: Students pick a recent geographical event in the news and prepare a presentation on it. The topic will be decided by students and teachers.

History	02/11/2020	27/11/2020	Students submit a project based around the theme "The Past in My Place". Students pick an aspect of local history that they would like to further research / investigate. Students' projects can take a variety of formats such as PowerPoint, poster, scrapbook etc. Students do not present this project, it will be handed up directly to the teacher.
Religion	22/02/2021	12/03/2021	This CBA is designed to facilitate students in undertaking an investigation into a person of personal interest to them who has made a positive impact on the world with a particular focus on exploring the values, worldview and/or belief that have influenced the person.
